Responsibilities

The Community Health Nurse Specialist (CHNS) and the Community Health Promotion Specialist (CHPS) work with schools, community coalitions, wellness committees, and the Hometown Health Improvement (HHI) team to improve the health of our children and our communities.

CHNS/CHPS are housed in the educational cooperatives around the state. Their work focus is to promote tobacco-free schools and communities, promote healthy eating, and healthy moving. They also address emergent public health issues including COVID-19, adolescent sexual health, mental health, injury prevention, and flu prevention.

CHNS support school nurses by providing resources, technical assistance, contact hours, and DESE/ADH updates.

CHPS support wellness committees in the schools and coordinated school health efforts across the state.
